- Oversee the enterprise, access, CPE, core, and edge networks to ensure network settings are secure and vulnerabilities are addressed in a timely manner.
- Monitor, create reports, and make recommendations based on customer traffic patterns and overall internet traffic flows by utilizing our carrier-class threat mitigation tools.
- Provide network security policy support and guidance for internal corporate IT/IS team.
- Work directly with external vendors to assess their security practices and develop solutions for any security issues found during testing, deployment, or on in-service equipment.
- Create methods and procedures for disaster recovery, logging, and reporting.
- Recommend policy for responding to security incidents.
- Maintain knowledge of network hardware, software versions, and current trends in the network security industry.
- Participate in network planning and network deployment strategies development as it relates to network security.
- Assist and guide Network Technicians and Operations Engineers in the installation, configuration, turn up, and modification of network equipment.

- Participate in network planning and network deployment strategies.
- Support Service Provider threat mitigation platforms (DDoS), firewalls, and VPN appliances (IPSec).
- Be a continuous subject matter expert. Expected to be a go-to resource.
- Provide assistance as needed to other teams for implementation, troubleshooting, and resolution of network security issues.
- Participate in equipment/materials vendor selection and 3<sup>rd</sup> party A&E vendor selection and maintain strong relationships with Archtop's vendors.
- Act as an ambassador and promoter of Archtop Fiber and Archtop's products. Ensure a positive Company image by working closely with trusted partners, external customers, community leaders, regulatory groups, and others.
