This position will work closely with the Sr. Manager of Construction, Director of Project Management, Office of Joint Use and others in Senior Leadership to establish and maintain Archtop's plant infrastructure, including our 100% fiber optic cable plant and network hub site buildings, cabinets, and colocations.

- Will ensure that all state and local municipalities and utilities guidelines are being adhered to

- Manage and assign Render responsibilities to our external construction partners.
- Will ensure that all Archtop approved branding related to contractor construction usage, i.e., truck magnets and cable reel covers, etc. are being adhered to
- Will be expected to be familiar with all Archtop safety requirements and procedures and ensure that they are being followed accordingly



- Responsible for coordination of customer-related damage or restoration issues.
- Assist with the preparation of weekly Construction progress reports.
- Other related tasks as assigned
